EXTENSION OF DEADLINES FOR PAYMENT OF PIS, COFINS AND EMPLOYERS' SOCIAL SECURITY CONTRIBUTION AND SUBMISSION OF DCTF AND EFD-CONTRIBUTIONS

In view of the difficulties plaguing companies as a result of COVID-19, the Federal Government has issued rules to **extend the payment deadlines for certain social contributions and the compliance with the corresponding ancillary obligations.**

- Ordinance 139 of the Ministry of Economy: extends the payment period for Employers' Social Security Contributions of Companies and Domestic Employers (CPP), PIS and COFINS related to March and April 2020, to be paid within the maturity period of contributions due in July and September 2020, respectively.
- Normative Instruction 1932, of the RFB: extends the delivery deadlines of DCTF and EFD-Contribution, so that:
 - DCTFs originally scheduled to be transmitted in April, May and June 2020, can be submitted until July 21, 2020; and
 - EFD-Contributions originally scheduled to be transmitted in April, May and June 2020, can be submitted until July 14, 2020.

It should be **noted** that:

- **PIS**, **COFINS** and **CPP** amounts maturing in March 2020 and which have not been paid are not supported by the extension;
- the extension does not reach **PIS** and **COFINS** amounts levied on the import of goods and services.
