




Bill of Law 1179/2020



Non-retroactivity of the effects of the pandemic on contract execution.

Exclusion of increased inflation, exchange rate variation, currency devaluation, or substitution of currency as unpredictable facts (except consumer).





STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS

Prevention/suspension of statutory periods until 10/30/2020.

COMPETITION

Ineffectiveness of articles dealing with the characterization of sale below cost price and cessation of activities of the company with out cause proven as an infraction of the economic order and the of classification associative contract, consortium or joint venture as an anti-trust case, in relation to the acts performed from 03/20/2020 until 10/30/2020 or while the state of public calamity, of Legislative Decree 6/2020, lasts.

Possibility of later analysis of the acts.

Need to interrupt the acts interpreted in accordance with the first item above until 10/30/2020.

Suspension of the 7-day withdrawal rule for perishable or immediate consumption products and medicines purchased for home delivery

LGPD

The General Data Protection Law will come into force on 01/31/2021, except in relation to the rules on the imposition of administrative sanctions, which will come into force on 08/01/2021.

LEASES

Impossibility of obtaining an injunction for eviction from 03/20/2020 (with exceptions) and until 10/30/2020.

Many of the issues related to Companies covered by the PL were the subject of Provisional Measure 931 of March 31, 2020.
